**ABOUT** The Nibble Entrepreneurship Program is a City of Somerville initiative to support members of our immigrant communities to learn about possible career opportunities in the food industry. So, if you like to cook and are interested in pursuing a culinary career — you may be interested in this opportunity. We offer a series of workshops; the sessions will be taught by a rotating group of city employees, business professionals and food business owners. The program also provides vending opportunities to qualified participants. Workshops will take place on Tuesday evenings, from 6-8pm, beginning on January 10th, 2023. COST: This program costs \$100; but qualified applicants will receive financial support and will only have to pay \$25.
