Are you interested in showcasing your culture through your food? Do you want to join a community of like-minded food lovers and storytellers? The Nibble Program could be for you!

About The Nibble Entrepreneurship Program is an initiative by the City of Somerville to help members of our immigrant and underserved communities learn about potential career and cultural opportunities in the food industry. The entrypoint into the Nibble Program is our 8-Week Workshop Series; essentially a crash course in food business careers, ownership and operations. Sessions will be led by a rotating group of City employees, business professionals, and food business owners. The program also offers sales opportunities to qualified participants via Nibble Kitchen restaurant, Farmers' Markets, Festivals, and more! Workshops will be held on Tuesday evenings, from 6-8 p.m., beginning in January 2025.

COST: This program costs \$100; financial support up to 100% is available for qualified participants.
